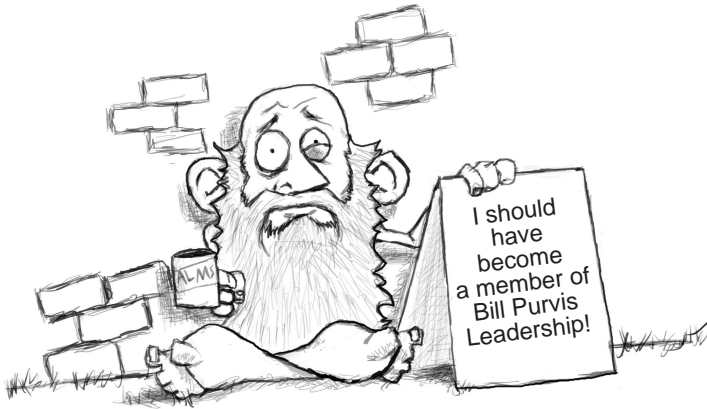
1. Real leaders see the need for personal growth.
